What is Crisis Intervention Partners?

Crisis Intervention Partners (CIP) training is a two day 16-hour program modeled after the philosophy of Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) programs. CIP serves as training for students to learn about and use *trauma informed care* (TIC) attitudes, beliefs, and verbal/non-verbal skills as part of their responses to crisis situations. CIP differs from CIT as it focuses on a wider range of students other than just law enforcers. CIP students are those who have professional or paraprofessional contact with people who suffer with mental illnesses and are in crisis. Accordingly, CIP participants include jail service and/or correctional officers, 911 dispatchers, Fire/EMS/EMT, Emergency Management personnel, hospital staff, social workers, school security personnel and more. Those of whom who are interested in better understanding and thus improving their crisis intervention outcomes, using TIC deescalation informed interactions with people in psychiatric crisis; are best suited for this program.

Program Learning Goals:

1. Overview of various mental illnesses (symptoms, treatments).
2. Basic education on human development & the impact of trauma.
3. Introduction to Trauma Informed Care
4. Education on safe, effective crisis de-escalation and active listening skills.
5. Self-care, Vicarious or Secondary Trauma, building support networks, and resiliency.
6. Excited Delirium
7. Auditory hallucination ('hearing voices') simulations.
8. Presentation & discussion with person living with mental illness.
