





Law Enforcement Officer Empowerment Opportunity for Police Officers, Deputy Sheriffs and Law Enforcement

NAMI Ozaukee, Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office and Ozaukee County Crisis Service of Ozaukee County Department of Human Services are hosting three sessions of Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training for law enforcement officers. The following are the three 2015 dates for the training:

- **1. April 20-24, 2015** from 8am-5pm held at the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office, 1201 S. Spring Street Port Washington WI 53074. (the deadline to apply is: March 20, 2015)
- 2. **September 21-25, 2015** from 8am-5pm held at the Grafton Police Department, 1981 Washington Street Grafton, WI 53024 (the deadline to apply is: September 1, 2015).
- 3. **October 12-16, 2015** at the Saukville Police Department, 649 East Green Bay Ave. Saukville, WI 53080 (*The deadline to apply is: September 21, 2015*).

CIT is a comprehensive five-day, 40-hour training session designed to assist law enforcement officers and other first responders in recognizing and understanding the signs and symptoms of mental illness including depression, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia and anxiety disorders, as well as other associated illnesses including developmental & cognitive disorders and dementia.

- You will learn various options to facilitate *de-escalation* of the mental health Consumer in crisis.
- You will learn about the legal issues associated with emergency commitments §Chapter 51.15
- You will learn about resources in your community that are available to the mental health consumer and their families.
- You will learn how interacting on a regular basis in this kind of outreach program reduces the potential for crisis and/or injury of the officer, consumer or others.

This training experience will be very challenging, not unlike these types of calls for service. Your effort will not be without rewards; the skills taught in this course will be used throughout your life both personally and professionally.

- This training is modeled after the recognized Best Practices "Memphis Model". Visit NAMI Ozaukee (namiozaukee.org) for additional information on CIT.
- There will be no charge for this training to attendees. Coffee and breakfast refreshments and full lunches will be provided at no cost to attendees by NAMI Ozaukee.
