Fall Family to Family class graduated on November 25, 2019 with 13 individuals completing the 12 week program. Thank you to Jeff Graf and Donna O'Connell, the facilitators. The manuals for the Fall Class were printed in memory of Garrett Dawkins. The NAMI Family to Family 8 week Curriculum includes: Principles, goals and feelings; Major mental illnesses; Mood disorders including PTSD and addiction; Basics about brain and biology of recovery; Problem solving workshop; Medication review; Empathy workshop; Communication skills workshop; Relative groups experience and self-care; Rehabilitation and recovery; Fighting stigma; and Advocacy.
